Wrestling State Brackets Announced on IHSAAtv.org

For the first time, the Indiana High School Athletic Association will announce the pairings for the IHSAA Wrestling State Finals via live webstream.

This Sunday (Feb. 11), each bracket in the 14 weight classes will be revealed on IHSAAtv.org beginning at 4 pm ET / 3 pm CT. The show will be hosted by Greg Rakestraw and Hall of Fame coach Mike Goebel and begin with the 106 pound weight class and continue through to the 285 pounders.

The 224 wrestlers qualifying for the 80th annual state finals will begin with first round matches on Friday, Feb. 16 at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. Those winning individuals will return Saturday morning (Feb. 17) for quarterfinal action with state championship bouts culminating that evening.

The IHSAA is a voluntary, not-for-profit organization that is self-supporting without the use of tax monies. Since its founding in 1903, the Association's mission has been to provide wholesome, educational athletics for the secondary schools of Indiana. A state tournament series is conducted annually in 21 sports, 10 for girls, 10 for boys and one co-ed (unified track and field). A 19-person board of directors, elected by member school principals, governs the organization.
