OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

CHESTERTON'S JEFF NIX TO BE HONORED AT STATE FINALS

Jeff Nix of Chesterton, Indiana is the recipient of the 2023-24 Interscholastic Athletic Official Award for excellence in the sport of Boys Basketball.

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each sport. Officials selected for this distinction have gone above and beyond to serve their association, community, and the IHSAA. Each have shown exceptional qualities of leadership, dedication, and loyalty to their sport, our student-athletes, and their fellow officials.



Jeff has been a licensed IHSAA basketball official for 31 years and has overseen 42 boys and girls' sectionals, 29 regionals, 12 semi-states, and four (4) state championship games, including the 2011, 2016, and 2021 Boys Basketball State Finals. Jeff is also a licensed official in baseball, softball, and football.

A member of the Lake County Officials Association, Nix currently serves as president of the association. He's previously served as basketball chair, boys basketball assigner, treasurer, and board member of the association. Additionally, Jeff has worked as an IHSAA certification clinician for basketball since 2000, assisting with clinics and training in service to other officials in his community. He's also spent time officiating and assigning for the numerous youth basketball leagues in Northwest Indiana, as well as officiating women's college basketball since 2022.

Jeff is most thankful for the relationships with fellow officials, coaches, and school administrators that officiating has provided him. He is grateful to have the opportunity to work in high school sports and give back to the community.

Nix works as a Project Manager for Falk PLI Engineering and Surveying in Portage, IN. He resides with his wife Michele and together they have two sons, Nathan and Ryan.

Jeff was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 11 sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes in Indiana.
