OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

SULLIVAN'S JAY SLATER TO BE HONORED AT STATE FINALS

Jay Slater of Sullivan, Indiana is the recipient of the 2023-24 Interscholastic Athletic Official Award for excellence in the sport of Girls Basketball

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each sport. Officials selected for this distinction have gone above and beyond to serve their association, community, and the IHSAA. Each have shown exceptional qualities of leadership, dedication, and loyalty to their sport, our student-athletes, and their fellow officials.



Jay has been a licensed IHSAA basketball official for 36 years and has overseen 32 girls' sectionals, 19 regionals, eight (8) semi-states, and five (5) Girls Basketball State Championship games (2007, 2010, 2013, 2016 and 2023). Slater has also worked four boys' basketball State Finals (2008, 2011, 2014 and 2017). In addition, he is a licensed football official and officiated the 2014, 2018 and 2022 football State Finals. Slater officiated in the 2019 Indiana North-South All-Star Football Game, the 2003 girls and 2004 boys' basketball Hall of Fame Classic events. Slater has also worked the baseball state finals in 2007, 2010, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019 and 2023.

Slater is a member of the Wabash Valley Officials Association. Slater previously served as a board member and president of the association. Slater has served as the baseball chair for the past 20 years and a lead clinician for the past 25 basketball clinics. He credits his success to the great group of officials he has worked with and learned from over the years.

Professionally, Slater worked at Sony in Terre Haute for over 30 years and was the Safety and Environmental Specialist. He retired March 31, 2022 and currently is the Safety and Environmental Specialist at Central Fab Great Dane in Terre Haute and has been there for 22 months.

Slater is a 1976 graduate of Shakamak High School, where he played basketball and baseball. He attended Heritage Environmental Institution. Slater and his wife, Cindy, have two children - Heather, 38, and Ashlee, 36. Jay also has 7 grandchildren: Kate, Addie, Ridge, Sadie, Charlee, Lexi and Quinn.
