THE 47TH ANNUAL IHSAA GIRLS GOLF STATE FINALS

Oct. 4-5, 2019

Prairie View Golf Club, Carmel, Ind.

A total of 15 teams have advanced five golfers each and 25 individuals have made it without their squads for a total of 100 participants. All teams and players will play 36 holes. Groups will be teeing off the 1st and 10th tees at 8:30 am ET / 7:30 am CT on Friday and at the same time on Saturday.

- Top-ranked and defending state champion Evansville North is shooting for its fifth title in the last six years. The Huskies are making their ninth consecutive appearance in the state finals, the most of any team competing this weekend. Two weeks ago, the team dropped a 281, the lowest score ever recorded in state tournament history, at Fendrich Golf Course in Evansville to win the sectional. They are led by senior Abigail Whittington who tied for ninth overall a year ago.
- Second-ranked Homestead is making the trek to Prairie View for the fourth consecutive season. The Spartans carded a 282, the lowest regional round in state tournament history, in last weekend's event played at Noble Hawk in Kendallville.
- No. 3 Zionsville, making its fifth straight state finals appearance after last year's runner-up finish, will be playing for its second state title in three seasons this weekend. The Eagles are led by Annabelle Pancake who enters the weekend as hot as any player in tournament history. The senior turned in a 65 at the sectional two weeks ago at West Chase in Brownsburg and followed that up with a 64 at the regional at Smock in Indianapolis. She also shot a 64 in last year's sectional at West Chase. She has finished tied for fourth each of the last two state finals tournaments and is one of eight players returning from last year's top 10.
- Jocelyn Bruch (pictured right) is the defending champion for No. 4 Westfield and returns for her senior year. She would become the first repeat champion since Chesterton's Kelly Grassel (2011, 2012).
- Nine of last year's 15 competing teams have returned to this year's state finals including nine of the top 10 teams in the final coaches poll from the Indiana High School Golf Coaches Association. Also, seven of the top 10 finishing teams have returned from last year's event.



NOTABLES

2018 Team State Champion: Evansville North claimed its fourth state championship in five years shooting a 605 to beat 2017 champion Zionsville (612) by seven strokes.

2018 Individual State Champion: Westfield's Jocelyn Bruch, a junior last year, returns and will look to become the first repeat champion since Chesterton's Kelly Grassel (2011, 2012).

Deadline is Wednesday, Oct. 2, at 4 pm ET / 3 pm CT. Approved requests will be left for pickup at the front gate entrance to Prairie View Golf Club.

Media Parking: News media should drive through the adjacent neighborhood to the golf course's front gate to claim their requested credential. From there, if space is available, you may proceed to the main parking lot next to the clubhouse.
