Pre-season rated No. 5 AP, unranked IBCA...in final poll, No. 2 AP, unranked IBCA, had moved into No. 1 position in January... started season 8-0...lost two of last four regular season games...avenged regular season loss (71-68) to No. 1 Lafayette Central Catholic (86-73) in regional championship game...has five regional titles (1947-69-70-71-02)...first-ever semi-state championship, though advanced to state finals under a different format in 1914...the 88-year span is the longest between two state finals appearances in tournament history...2-0 in overtime games this year...has highest scoring total season offense in final-eight (71.6)...top scoring offense of final-eight during tourney play (73.3)...has highest defensive average among final-eight (60.8)...Jeff Henley's father, Bill, was head basketball coach at New Winchester (1947-48) and Williamsburg (1949-53).
