## 2001-02 IHSAA Softball State Tournament Series

## **State Finals Summary**

The 18th Annual IHSAA Softball State Finals Tournament saw Lake Central, Evansville Memorial and Clinton Prairie each win their respective tournaments on June 7-8, 2002 at the Cherry Tree Softball Complex in Carmel.

In all, 6,266 students comprising 356 schools began play at the sectional level of this year's tournament.

#### Class 3A

#### Lake Central Tops Center Grove For 3A State Championship

With three runs in the fifth inning, Lake Central broke open a close game and went on to an 8-1 victory over Center Grove for the Class 3A championship of the 2002 IHSAA Girls Softball State Finals on June 7-8, 2002 at Cherry Tree Softball Complex in Carmel.

It was the second softball state title for Lake Central (28-1) with both coming over Center Grove as the opponent. The Indians had defeated the Trojans, 4-2, for the 1992 state championship. It also was the fourth title overall for the school and its first since 1994 when the girls basketball team was crowned.

With Lake Central leading 2-1 in the bottom of the fifth inning, freshman DH Katie Mitchell sent a two-out, two-run homer over the centerfield wall. It was Mitchell's third round-tripper of the year and the first home run registered in a state finals game since 1996.

Ali Pienta drove in the third Lake Central run of the inning with a double down the left field line that scored Jill Kapitan from first base to make the score 5-1.

The Indians, coached by Keith Hauber, added three more runs in the bottom of the sixth inning with much of the damage due to three Center Grove errors. Yvette Tovar scored from third on a wild pitch and Amy Stremplewski scored from second on the ensuing throwing error by the Trojans catcher. Kapitan then drove in Brandi Shields with an RBI single through the left side.

Lindsey Galloway's triple to right field in the Center Grove fourth scored Megan Hall to put the Trojans up 1-0. Hall had singled two batters earlier.

The lead was short-lived, however, as Lake Central answered in its half of the inning as Pienta and Terrilyn Schilling both smacked RBI doubles scoring Mitchell and Pienta, respectively.

Brooke Baker (19-1) went the distance to earn the pitching victory giving up only three hits and striking out seven, four in the last two innings. Ashley Young (14-2) collected the loss for Center Grove.

Center Grove, playing in its state-best sixth championship contest, finished its third state runner-up season (1992 and 1996) at 32-2. The Trojans were coached by Russ Milligan.

In Friday's semifinals, Center Grove put together a 1-0 victory over Noblesville (28-3), a first-time visitor to the state finals. Lake Central earned its way into the final game with its own 1-0 win over Fort Wayne Northrop (27-5).

Amy Kendall of Fort Wayne Northrop was selected by members of the IHSAA Executive Committee as the winner of the Mental Attitude Award in Class 3A Softball. Farm Bureau Insurance, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Fort Wayne Northrop High School in the name of Amy Kendall.

#### Class 2A

#### Evansville Memorial Shuts Out Blackford For 2A Crown

With outstanding pitching from senior Leslie Nichols and error-free defense, the Evansville Memorial Tigers picked up their first state title in softball with a 3-0 victory over Blackford on June 7-8, 2002 in the 18th Annual IHSAA Girls Softball Championships at the Cherry Tree Softball Complex in Carmel.

Sophomore DH Elise Mehringer put Memorial up 1-0 in the third inning sending an RBI single to rightfield with two outs which scored Ashley Wannemuehler.

That run turned out to be all Memorial needed, but they added a pair in the top of the sixth when Mehringer bunted her way on and then stole second. Lauren Logel reached on a fielders' choice and Nichols put the icing on the cake with a single up the middle which drove in both baserunners.

Nichols went the distance in the pitchers circle for the Tigers (25-10-1), allowing only two hits, while issuing but one walk and striking out 10. She finishes the season with a 13-4 record. With the state championship, Memorial coach Bob McFall earned his 100<sup>th</sup> coaching victory in just his fourth season.

Brandi Thomas took the loss for Blackford, allowing six hits and one base on balls, with seven strikeouts and finishing her campaign at 22-6. Blackford, coached by Tony King, finished 26-6 for the season.

In the Friday semifinals, Blackford tallied three runs in the fifth inning and blanked 2000 2A champ Mt. Vernon (Fortville) (22-8), 3-0. Bruins pitcher Brandi Thomas struck out 13 batters helping Blackford to its first title game appearance.

That same evening, Evansville Memorial advanced via a 2-0 victory over Cass (26-3-1). The Tigers scored both runs in the top of the seventh inning to earn their second appearance in the Class 2A final in the last three years.

Christina Machuca of Reitz Memorial High School in Evansville was selected by members of the IHSAA Executive Committee as the winner of the Mental Attitude Award in Class 2A Softball. Farm Bureau Insurance, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Evansville's Reitz Memorial High School in the name of Christina Machuca.

#### Class A

#### First Appearance No Problem For Clinton Prairie

Clinton Prairie scored the only run it needed in the first inning and went on to celebrate a 5-0 victory over Clarksville in the Class A state championship game June 7-8, 2002 at the Cherry Tree Complex in Carmel.

The Gophers (24-4), making their first appearance in the state finals, also scored once each in the third and fifth innings and twice more in the top of the sixth when freshman catcher Janette Burgin tripled to the centerfield wall and scored on a throwing error which also plated Melissa Nance.

Clarksville (28-1), also making its first trip to the state finals, threatened in the bottom of the sixth inning advancing runners to second and third with no outs but couldn't capitalize. It was the first loss of the season for the Generals, who committed seven errors. No state championship team has finished a season unbeaten.

Both teams advanced to the championship game after winning hard-fought marathon contests on Friday night.

Clinton Prairie, coached by Randy Cooper, won a 6-4 decision from Pioneer (22-11) in 14 innings. Tied 1-1 after seven innings, the Gophers erupted for five runs in the top of the 14<sup>th</sup> and held off Pioneer, which scored three times in the bottom half of the inning and had runners at second and third with the winning run at the plate.

Clarksville, coached by Tim Hauber, earned its berth in the final game with a 2-1 victory over Riverton Parke (23-9) in 15 innings. The game tied a state finals record for longest game and was completed at approximately 1:40 a.m.

Amy Gum of Riverton Parke High School was selected by members of the IHSAA Executive Committee as the winner of the Mental Attitude Award in Class A Softball. Farm Bureau Insurance, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Riverton Parke High School in the name of Gum.
