

2001-02 IHSAA Volleyball State Tournament Series

State Finals Summary

Indianapolis Cathedral, Delta, Muncie Burriss and Michigan City Marquette each captured championships in the 30th Annual IHSAA Volleyball State Finals held Saturday, November 3, 2001 at Hinkle Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. Those four schools survived their respective tournaments that began with a total of 384 schools and 5,344 student-athletes. North Central (4A), Pike (3A) and Ben Davis (2A) high schools, all in Indianapolis, along with Hinkle Fieldhouse (A) served as state semifinal sites in the morning with all four championship matches being played at Hinkle in the afternoon and evening. This was the first year the state finals were played at the venerable building located on the Butler University campus.

Class 4A

Indianapolis Cathedral Grabs School's First Class 4A State Title

Indianapolis Cathedral won its first Class 4A volleyball state championship and third overall with a decisive 15-5, 15-5 victory over Franklin. The Irish, playing in Class 4A for the first time, were the Class 3A state champions in 1997 and 1999.

The fifth-ranked Irish finished the season 32-7 with 10 straight victories. That run began Oct. 13 with a 15-11, 15-8 triumph over Franklin.

In the state championship match, sophomore Moria McCarthy led Indianapolis Cathedral with seven kills and classmate Alex Montefalco added six.

As in their previous two title runs, the Irish were coached by Jean Kesterson.

Jessie Wagner, a senior outside hitter, led Franklin with nine kills and senior middle hitter Erin DeBoy added six in eight attempts. The unranked Grizzly Cubs (34-5), who reached the state finals for the first time, were coached by Scott McQueen.

Indianapolis Cathedral advanced to the state championship match by upsetting previously unbeaten and second-ranked Michigan City 15-11, 14-16, 15-5. Michigan City was the last team to defeat Cathedral during the regular season, a 15-12, 14-16, 15-12 decision back on October 13. In the other semifinal match, Franklin downed third-ranked New Castle 16-14, 15-12.

Erin DeBoy a senior at Franklin Community High School, was named the 2001 recipient of the IHSAA Mental Attitude Award in Class 4A Volleyball. Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 check to Franklin Community High School in the name of DeBoy.

Class 3A

Third Time The Charm For Delta

Top-ranked Delta stormed to its first IHSAA championship in any sport with a 15-5, 15-5 triumph over Fort Wayne Bishop Luers in the Class 3A championship match.

After trailing 5-4 in the opening game, the Eagles never trailed again. They scored the final 11 points in the first game, and grabbed a 5-0 lead in the second game to take command. Delta (35-4) scored the final seven points of game two to clinch the victory.

Guided by fourth-year coach Robb Painter, Delta captured the crown in its third state finals appearance. The Eagles were the Class 3A state runner-up in 1997 and 1998.

Senior Jenna Cox led Delta with eight kills in 20 attempts. Junior setter Blair Buchanan was credited with 16 assists. Delta finished the season with 22 straight victories, including seven in tournament play.

Fort Wayne Bishop Luers, coached by Joyce Moss, finished 25-13 after making its first state finals appearance. The unranked Knights continued a Cinderella tournament run by coming from behind to defeat sixth-ranked Providence, 12-15, 15-12, 15-3, in the semifinals. Delta followed by ousting unranked Frankfort, 15-4, 15-5.

Junior Nicole Howe paced Bishop Luers with five kills against Delta. Michelle King contributed eight assists.

Diana Zipp, a senior at Our Lady of Providence High School, was selected by the IHSAA Executive Committee as the Class 3A recipient of the IHSAA Mental Attitude Award in volleyball. Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 check to Providence High School in the name of Zipp.

Class 2A

Muncie Burris Continues 2A Dominance

Muncie Burris jumped to an early lead in the first game and rolled to its fifth consecutive Class 2A state championship with a 15-3, 15-3 victory over previously unbeaten and top-ranked Mitchell.

The Class 2A second-ranked Owls (34-6) jumped out to a 12-0 lead in game one and never looked back in winning the 13th state title in the school's illustrious volleyball history. Besides its five Class 2A titles, Burris also won championships in the single class format in 1982, 1985, 1986, 1989, 1990, 1992, 1993 and 1994. Steve Shondell has coached the Owls to every state championship.

Muncie Burris junior Amanda McCormick led all players with 10 kills, while senior Ashley Bell tallied 20 assists and junior Jamie Waters put up seven digs on the defensive side.

In semifinals action, Burris defeated Triton (27-11), 15-2, 15-10, while Mitchell handled Monrovia (26-8), 15-5, 15-8, for its berth in the championship. For Mitchell, it was the Bluejackets first trip to the championship match after making the state finals field in Class 3A a year ago. Mitchell (35-1) was coached by John Tyree.

Meghan Tyree, a senior at Mitchell High School, was named the 2001 recipient of the Mental Attitude Award in Class 2A Volleyball by members of the IHSAA Executive Committee. Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 check to Mitchell High School in the name of Tyree.

Class A

Michigan City Marquette Three-Peats In Class A Tournament

Michigan City Marquette swept past Barr-Reeve, 15-5, 15-1, to claim its third consecutive IHSAA Class A state title.

The Class A top-ranked Blazers (35-4) got 15 kills from junior outside hitter Kelly Cochran and six each from senior Lauren Laramore, sophomore Colette Hausoul and junior Lesley Pahs. Pahs, the Marquette setter, tallied 36 assists.

The three-time state champions were led by second-year coach Jim Dove. Over the past three years, the Blazers have compiled a 113-6 record. Seventh-ranked Barr-Reeve, coached by Amber Guinn, finished as the state runner-up for the second time in four years finishing at 28-6. The Vikings were the runner-up to Clinton Prairie in 1998.

Barr-Reeve was led by junior Jennifer Wirtz with 12 kills.

Michigan City Marquette earned its spot in the championship match with a 7-15, 15-8, 15-11 semifinal victory over third-ranked Cowan (27-10). The two teams had met the last two years in the state championship match. Barr-Reeve outlasted fourth-ranked Morristown (32-6) in the other semifinal match, 15-2, 7-15, 15-8.

Lauren Laramore, a senior at Michigan City Marquette High School, was named the 2001 recipient of the IHSAA Mental Attitude Award in Class A Volleyball. Farm Bureau Insurance, corporate partner of the IHSAA, presented a \$1,000 check to Marquette High School in the name of Laramore.
