SIX FIRST-TIMERS TO TAKE FLOOR AT CONSECO FIELDHOUSE ON SATURDAY

When the 93rd Annual IHSAA Boys Basketball State Finals tip off this Saturday at Consecro Fieldhouse in Indianapolis, the field will have quite a fresh look and feel to it as six of this year's eight finalists have never advanced to this level of the tournament.

The two teams that have been here, however, Lafayette Central Catholic in Class A and Pike in Class 4A, have established their programs well in recently and will be looking for their third state championships in the last six years.

In Saturday's **Class A** title game, Central Catholic (17-9) will be facing a familiar opponent in Southwestern (Shelbyville) (22-4). The two teams will be meeting for the second time this season following an 80-48 Central Catholic home victory on Feb. 8. The 32-point difference was the largest margin of victory and defeat for the respective teams this season.

No team has ever won a state championship with more than nine losses in a season, but two have suffered that many and still won the big trophy and the Knights hope to join that pair. Anderson finished 22-9 in 1935 and Jasper won the 1949 championship following a 21-9 season.

Southwestern, meanwhile, won its first regional championship this season and turned that momentum into the school's first state finals appearance. The Spartans also hope to win the school's first state championship in any team sport and the first in Shelby County history since 1947 (Shelbyville, boys basketball).

In **Class 2A**, top-ranked and unbeaten Cass (25-0) will size up eighth-ranked Forest Park (23-4) in the second game of the day.

Directed by Hall of Fame coach Basil Mawbey now in his third year at the school, the Kings are holding opponents to a state low 33.3 points per game through 25 games. They are also beating teams by a 23.3 point margin, second best in the state. Cass has gone 67-3 in three years under Mawbey, including 45-1 the last two years. After an unbeaten regular season one year ago, the Kings were upset in last year's opening round of sectionals. Cass, along with Class 4A Pike, will look to complete an unbeaten season and join a group of six other state champions to have accomplished the feat, the last being Marion (29-0) in 1985, the first of its three consecutive titles.

Mawbey will be bringing his third different school to the state finals after winning the 1983 state title at Connersville and guiding Kokomo to appearances in 1989 and 1997.

Forest Park also has caught fire this tournament season. The Rangers won their first sectional title in 10 years and, subsequently, went on to the first regional and semi-state championships in school history. Forest Park stumbled in two of its last four regular season games, but never lost any of its four games by more than eight points. Interestingly, they are the only team among the eight finalists to have actually increased their tournament scoring average from the regular season (66.1 up from 63.7).

Two sets of Trojans will meet in the evening session's first game for the **Class 3A** championship as Fort Wayne Elmhurst (22-5) and Indianapolis Bishop Chatard (21-2) tip it off.

The unranked Elmhurst Trojans will be making the school's very first appearance in a state finals event in any team sport this weekend. The school has been an IHSAA member since 1931. Despite being outrebounded by 17, Elmhurst was able to force 24 turnovers to upset No. 1 Gary Roosevelt, 71-68, in the Lafayette Jefferson Semi-State last Saturday. Six-foot-seven junior forward James Hardy leads the Trojans of coach Keith Edmonds in several statistical categories including points per game (22.9), rebounds per game (8.7) and assists per game (3.9).

Second-ranked Bishop Chatard, for many years known for its football prowess that includes six state titles, hopes to claim the school's first IHSAA championship off the gridiron. These Trojans, seven of which played on the Class 3A state football champs last November, enjoyed a two-week stand atop the Class 3A state poll in mid-January and have hovered near the top since. They also have celebrated the school's first regional and semi-state championships this season. Like Hardy, Dan Cage, a 6-5 senior who splits time at guard and forward, leads his team in several categories, including points (18.9), rebounds (5.3) and assists (4.3). Chatard has held its tournament opponents to just 43.0 points on defense.

The big school matchup in **Class 4A** pits a pair of deep and talented teams in fourth-ranked and once-beaten DeKalb (26-1) going up against top-ranked and unbeaten Pike (28-0).

DeKalb suffered its only loss on Jan. 25, a 56-53 overtime setback at Columbia City, but the Barons avenged their only blemish come tournament time with a 55-49 double overtime triumph in the sectional championship game. Since that contest, DeKalb won its three ensuing games by an average of 15.3 points and will make the trip to Indianapolis for the state finals for the first time. Coach Cliff Hawkins' charges, who won the Hall of Fame Classic in December, also have ratcheted up the defense in post-season action only allowing 43.6 points per game in five outings. Hawkins, in his 11th year at DeKalb, will be coaching his 500th varsity game in 22 seasons on Saturday.

The Red Devils of Pike are back in the 4A title contest for the third straight year and, like Lafayette Central Catholic in Class A, will be after their third championship in six years. After winning it all in 1998 and 2001, the Devils of second year coach Larry Bullington fell in last year's game to Gary West Side, 58-55, that went to the wire.

This season Pike is scoring at a 73.1 per game clip and is outdoing its opponents by a state best 24.0 points per game. The team moved up one spot to No. 2 in the country according to the *USA Today* Super 25 Rankings as of Monday and hopes to finish the campaign undefeated along with Class 2A finalist Cass.
