Tennis Coaches Proposals

Tim Cleland of the Indiana High School Tennis Coaches Association (IHSTeCA) appeared before the Executive Committee and presented the following rules proposals for consideration:

Proposal 1: Coaches should be allowed to coach outside the fence only between points at varsity, JV, and freshman levels of tennis and in all regular season matches, as long as the instruction is brief and does not disrupt the flow of the match. The limit of 20 seconds between points still applies.

Proposal 2: In dual matches, junior varsity and freshman players should be allowed to play more than one time, regardless of the number of players on the other team. (The maximum limit should be two 8-game pro sets or three 6-game sets, or their equivalent.)

Proposal 3: An admission charge of \$5 per person should be extended to IHSAA regionals in boys' and girls' tennis.

No decisions were made but these proposals will be considered at the March Executive Committee meeting.

NFHS Football Rules Committee Meeting Report

Assistant Commissioner Robert Faulkens reported on the recent NFHS Football Rules Committee Meeting he attended. He discussed the NFHS's recent announcement on the adoption of the 40-second play clock after Indiana and several other states experimented with the rule over the last three years. By state adoption, state associations are now permitted create instant replay procedures to be used only during the state tournament games. Also, rules were also clarified regarding the size of jersey numbers with those requirements taking effect in coming seasons. Legislature Report

Commissioner Bobby Cox reported on recent activity in the state legislature and bills related to the IHSAA and high school athletics.

Penalties Assessed

Anderson HS – Rule 52-3 (*Boys' basketball player participated in six quarters in a single session*)

1. The Anderson High School boys' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. All six quarters shall count against the maximum number of quarters allowed for the student athlete involved in this violation.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9, Anderson High School shall forfeit the varsity contest if victorious and the opposing school shall be notified of this violation

Avon HS – Rule 19-3 (*JV football player participated in a game without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Avon High School football program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contest where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Avon High School was victorious. The opposing school shall be notified of this violation.

Avon HS – Rule 19-3 (*C-Team girls' basketball player participated in multiple games without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Avon High School girls' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contests where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Avon High School was victorious. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Avon HS – Rule 19-3 (*JV wrestler participated in a match without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Avon High School wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contest where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited and the event rescored to reflect this forfeiture. The opposing school(s) shall be notified of this violation.

Calumet HS – Rule 9-16 (*Girls swimming team withdrew from second day of sectional competition*)

1. The Calumet High School girls' swimming and diving program is issued a warning. A warning denotes that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Coach Adriana Martinez is reprimanded for her role in removing her team from the sectional swimming and diving meet. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable explanation for rules violations.

Carmel HS – NFHS Wrestling Rule 4-4-3 (*Multiple wrestlers were allowed to use weight loss suits in practices – PROBATION*)

1. The Carmel High School wrestling program is placed on probation. Probation is a serious warning that a violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated. Further transgressions committed by the wrestling program may be met with more severe consequences which include, but not limited to, suspension from the IHSAA tournament series.
2. Head Coach Ed Pendowski is severely reprimanded for allowing these violations to be committed. There is absolutely no rationale to defend this behavior.
3. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions exercised to date by Carmel High School with Coach Pendowski.
4. As per Rule 4-4-3 of the NFHS Wrestling Rules Book, all athletes listed above should have been disqualified from competition in events occurring after the illegal acts. Carmel High School shall review the records for each of these students. In every instance where a student implemented the use of a weight loss suit, the subsequent interscholastic competition shall be recorded as a forfeit. Carmel High School shall recalculate all team scores and notify all opposing schools of these forfeitures and recalculations.

5. In lieu of the suspension of Coach Ed Pendowski for the remainder of the season, the IHSAA accepts Carmel High School's suggestion of a monetary fine. This penalty shall arrive at the Association prior to the beginning of the IHSAA Wrestling Sectional Tournament.

Chesterton HS – Rules 5-2 and 15-2.2c (*Five boys soccer players received instruction from the coaching staff in a non-school sponsored facility. Two players received free admissions to the non-school sponsored facility - PROBATION*)

1. The Chesterton High School boys' soccer program is placed on probation for the 2019-20 school year. Probation is a serious warning that violations have occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated. Further transgressions committed by the boys' soccer program may be met with more severe consequences which include, but not limited to, suspension from the IHSAA tournament series.
2. Student athletes Nick Biel and Seth Conway are hereby declared ineligible for interscholastic participation immediately for violation of the provisions of Rule 5-2. As per the provisions of Rule 5-4a, the students may apply in writing for reinstatement for the violation of their amateur status.
3. Head Coach Lucas Sabedra is severely reprimanded for this violation. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable rationale for a rule violation. It is strongly encouraged that Coach Sabedra be educated thoroughly with respect to the IHSAA by-laws by the Chesterton High School administration.
4. The IHSAA accepts the suspension of Coach Sabedra for the first two contests of the 2019-20 season by Chesterton High School.

Christel House Academy – Rule 18-1 (*Two girls' basketball players participated in two games while academically ineligible*)

1. The Christel House Academy girls' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The students are declared ineligible until such time the students may become academically eligible.
3. The interscholastic contests in which the ineligible athletes participated in shall be forfeited if Christel House was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Culver Academies – Rule 20-1 (*Assistant boys' basketball coach exercised undue influence on a student athlete – PROBATION*)

1. The Culver Academies boys' basketball program is placed on probation for the remainder of the 2018-19 school year. Probation is a serious warning that a violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated. Further transgressions committed by the boys' basketball program may be met with more severe consequences which include, but not limited to, suspension from the IHSAA tournament series.
2. The IHSAA accepts the suspension of student athlete Daley Stein from varsity competition in all IHSAA sports for the 2018-19 school year.
3. Assistant Coach Bill Murchie is severely reprimanded for these violations. Ignorance of IHSAA by-laws is no excuse for a violation.
4. It is recognized and encouraged by the IHSAA that Culver Academies will hold mandatory educational sessions with all coaches to insure understanding of IHSAA by-laws and policies.

Elkhart Central HS – Rule 60-6 (*Wrestler failed to meet all provisions of the weight management program*)

1. The Elkhart Central High School wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Zach Wickcar is reprimanded for allowing these violations to be committed. The head coach holds the responsibility that each athlete meets all requirements of the Association's wrestling weight management plan.
3. The matches in which the ineligible wrestler participated prior to satisfying all requirements of the program shall be forfeited if the student was victorious. All events where a team score was tallied shall be rescored to reflect these forfeitures. All opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Fort Wayne North Side HS – Rule 19-3 (*Wrestler participated in several matches without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Fort Wayne North Side wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.

2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The wrestling meets the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete if a team score was calculated. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Fremont HS – Rule 19-3 (*Junior varsity girls' basketball player participated in multiple games without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Fremont High School girls' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contests where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Fremont was victorious. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Hammond Bishop Noll HS – Rule 19-3 (*Junior varsity football player participated in multiple games without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Hammond Bishop Noll High School football program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contests where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Hammond Bishop Noll was victorious. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Lake Station Edison HS – Rule 19-3 (*Wrestler participated in two meets without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Lake Station Edison wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The wrestling meets the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete if a team score was calculated. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Lakeland Christian Academy – Rule 19-3 (*Boys' basketball player participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer on file*)

1. The Lakeland Christian Academy boys' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contests where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Lakeland Christian was victorious. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Lawrence Central HS – Rule 60-6 (*Two wrestlers failed to meet all provisions of the weight management program*)

1. The Lawrence Central High School wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Joshua Franklin is reprimanded for allowing these violations to be committed. The head coach holds the responsibility that each athlete meets all requirements of the Association's wrestling weight management plan.

Southport HS – Rule 60-6 (*Wrestler participated in weight classes below the student's established minimum weight*)

1. The Southport High School wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Nick Skinner is reprimanded for committing this violation. The head coach holds the responsibility that each athlete meets all requirements of the Association's wrestling weight management plan.
3. All instances where the student participated in a weight class below his established minimum weight shall not count toward meeting the minimum of six qualifying weigh-ins to be eligible for the IHSAA tournament series.

Wabash HS – Rule 60-2 (*Wrestler participated in seven multi-school events*)

1. The Wabash High School wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.

2. Head Coach Jake O'Neill is reprimanded for committing this violation. The head coach holds the responsibility of insuring that students do not exceed the maximum number of events.
3. The matches in which the ineligible athlete participated (IHSWCA Team State Duals) shall be forfeited if victorious and the scores of the meets shall be rescored removing these points. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Wawasee HS – Rule 15-1.3 (*Diver attended a non-school sponsored camp*)

1. The Wawasee High School girls' swimming and diving program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. In lieu of suspension from the 2018-19 IHSAA tournament series in swimming and diving, student athlete Kelsey Keiper is suspended for first two interscholastic contests on the Wawasee High School girls' swimming and diving schedule for the 2019-20 season.

Whitko HS – Rule 60-6 (*Wrestler was allowed to participate below his established minimum weight on multiple occasions*)

1. The Whitko High School wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Mike Biddle is reprimanded for allowing these violations to be committed. The head coach holds the responsibility that each athlete meets all requirements of the Association's wrestling weight management plan.
