State Finals Preview: Two Defending Champion Return

For the second year in a row, plenty of new faces are expected to stand at the top of the awards podium this weekend during the 79th Annual IHSAA Boys Swimming & Diving State Finals at the Indiana University Natatorium in Indianapolis.

Like last year's state meet, only two individuals return who were crowned state champion in last year's final meet.

Gabriel Swardson of Fort Wayne Snider surprised a few last year in winning the 100 butterfly in 49.14. He'll be looking for a repeat performance to cap off his senior season and enters Friday's prelims with the eighth-best time in 50.71.

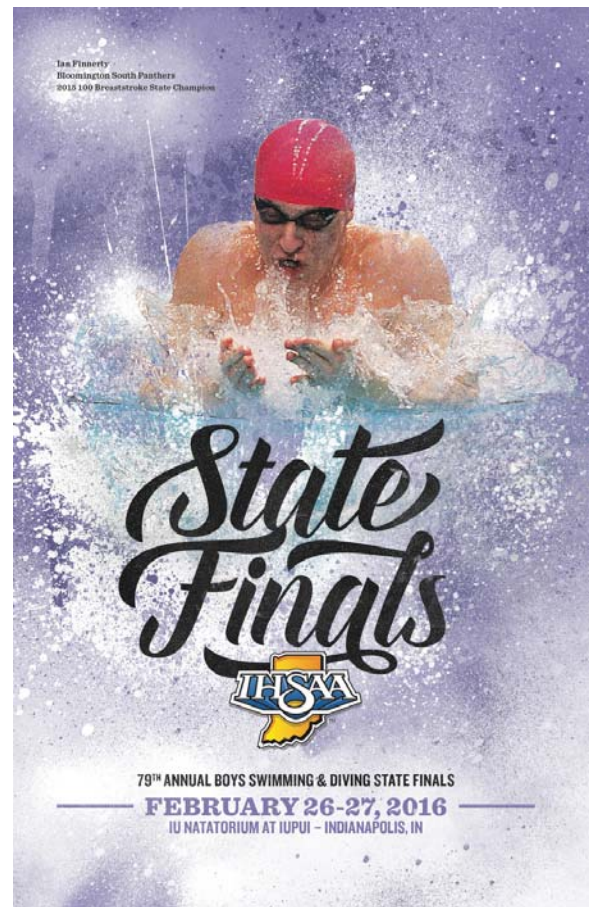
County rival Ryan Huizing, a senior out of Carroll (Fort Wayne) swam the fastest time in the state in the 100 fly (49.34) last Saturday. He also enters with a state-best 20.71 in the 50 freestyle and is the only top seed in two events. If he pulls off either race, he would become Carroll's first swimming state champion.

The other returning state champ is Homestead diver Kevin Frebel. The senior recorded a state-best 560.55 points in Tuesday's diving regional on the one meter springboard and just under the 568.65 points he put up to win last year's state competition.

The final state coaches poll has No. 1 Zionsville, last year's state runner-up, followed by Northridge, Avon and Carroll (Fort Wayne), respectively, with Fishers and Carmel tied for fifth. Those teams appear to be the prime contenders this weekend. Carmel is the defending state champion and winner in four of the last six years. Perennial power Chesterton cannot be discounted either having split the last eight crowns with Carmel.

Preliminary swimming heats get underway Friday night at 6 pm ET / 5 pm CT. The top 16 in each event will return for competition on Saturday with the top eight individuals vying for state championship honors. Those finishing ninth through 16th on Friday will make up the competitors in the consolation heats. All diving will take place on Saturday beginning at 9 am ET / 8 am CT with the top 20 of 32 competitors advancing from the prelims to the semis after five dives each. After three dives each in the semis, the top 16 will advance to the final round for another three dives each. All championship and consolation finals, including diving, will commence at 1 pm ET / 12 pm CT on Saturday.

Saturday's championship and consolation finals will be streamed live on IHSAAtv.org beginning at 1 pm ET/12 CT with Thad Vandeventer, 11-time state championship coach Tony Young (swimming analyst), Dan Johnson (diving analyst), and Vaso Michels (deck reporter).
