State Finals Summary

North Central Edges Fort Wayne Canterbury In Penalty Kick Shootout For State Championship

North Central of Indianapolis outscored defending state champion Fort Wayne Canterbury, 3-2, in a penalty kick shootout, to take a 2-1 victory for this year's IHSAA state championship on November 2, 2002 at Kuntz Memorial Stadium in Indianapolis.

In the final attempt, senior Bill Welch scored the decisive goal off the Canterbury goalkeeper to avoid a sudden victory situation and give the Panthers their fourth state title (1994, 1995, 1996). Each team chose five different players to take kicks from the penalty line. North Central converted on three of its five attempts, while Canterbury scored only twice.

It was the second time the boys championship match went to a penalty kick shootout with North Central coming up on the short end in 2000 losing to Castle, 1-0 (5-3 in the shootout), for the title.

It was a matchup of two perennial heavyweights with each team credited with three state championships a piece in the tournament's previous eight years.

The Panthers jumped out to a 1-0 lead 13:15 into the match when Canterbury deflected a cross kick into its own net. Canterbury evened the score a little more than four minutes later when senior Kyle Schwartz chipped in a shot from freshman Philip Wilson over the keeper's head. The teams played the second half and a pair of seven-minute overtime periods before the shootout phase.

To gain their spots in the championship match, North Central, coached by Jerry Little, defeated Merrillville, 2-0, while Canterbury, coached by Greg Mauch, bettered Evansville Memorial, 3-0, in the other semifinal. North Central completed a 22-3-1 season with Canterbury concluding at 18-5-2.

Kent Melchiors of Evansville Memorial was selected by members of the IHSAA Executive Committee as the winner of the C. Eugene Cato Mental Attitude Award in Boys Soccer. Farm Bureau Insurance, the IHSAA corporate partner, presented a \$1,000 scholarship to Evansville's Reitz Memorial High School in the name of Kent Melchiors.
