Baseball State Tournament Pairings Announced

A field of 379 teams will begin play later this month as the pairings for the 54th Annual IHSAA Baseball State Tournament Series were announced this evening in Indianapolis.

Host schools will announce playing schedules in the days to come which will then be added to the online brackets at MaxPreps.com the week before the tournament begins.

Sectional competition begins Wednesday, May 26, and continues through Monday, May 31 (Memorial Day), with the 64 champions advancing to the four-team regionals on Saturday, June 5. Two semifinal games will be played early that day at each site with the two winners returning for a championship game that evening. The 16 regional winners will be assigned to four semi-state sites and play a single game on Saturday, June 12, with the winners moving into their respective state championship game.

The four state championship games will be played at Victory Field in Indianapolis, home of the Triple-A franchise Indianapolis Indians, for the 23rd year overall. This year's games will be played in a doubleheader format on Monday, June 21 and Tuesday, June 22, three days later than the traditional weekend slot due to Indians home games.



Among the top-ranked teams in [this week's poll](#) from the Indiana High School Baseball Coaches Association (IHSBCA), Class 4A's **Columbus North Bull Dogs** will begin their journey against East Central in Sectional 14 opening game at Bloomington North. The **Hanover Central Wildcats**, the No. 1 team in Class 3A, will meet home-standing Kankakee Valley in Sectional 18; the **Monroe Central Golden Bears** are No. 1 in Class 2A and will take on Frankton in Sectional 40 at Lapel and; the **Oldenburg Academy Twisters**, the top team in Class A, will start with Trinity Lutheran in Sectional 60 at Jac-Cen-Del.

The teams that won state championships two seasons ago include the **Hamilton Southeastern Royals** who will take on Fishers in Sectional 8 at Westfield. The **Andrean Fighting 59ers**, now competing in 4A after winning the 2018 and 2019 3A state championships will meet Hobart in Sectional 2 at Chesterton. The last Class 2A champion, the **Alexandria Monroe Tigers** drew Winchester Community in Sectional 40 at Lapel. The **University Trailblazers**, now competing in 2A, were the 2019 Class A state champions and will face Covenant Christian (Indianapolis) in Sectional 43 at Cascade.

About the Draw

To conduct the random drawing for the baseball state tournament, the IHSAA places ping-pong balls representing each school in a given sectional into a lottery-style air mix machine. A motorized fan in the bottom of the machine blows the balls around the inside of the transparent container and air then forces each ball up through a tube in random order. For example, the first ball retrieved from the machine will be the visiting team in game one with the second ball representing the home team in game one. The third ball to come out is the visitor in game two and the fourth ball the home team in game two. That same method is followed through all 64 sectionals and 16 regionals.
