### State Finals Preview: Lafayette Central Catholic Chasing History, Six Others Look to Land First Baseball Crown

Lafayette Central Catholic will look to equal a major state record while six others aim to become their school's first baseball champions in this weekend's 50<sup>th</sup> Annual IHSAA State Finals at beautiful Victory Field in Indianapolis.

The Class 4A state championship game will lead off the weekend on Friday night at 7:30 pm ET with the Class A, 2A and 3A games contested at 1 pm ET, 4 pm ET and 7 pm ET, respectively, on Saturday. All four games will be played at the home of the Indianapolis Indians, the Triple-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates.


Each game will be televised live on Fox Sports Indiana and streamed at IHSAAtv.org. Greg Rakestraw, Rob Blackman and Jeremiah Johnson will serve as the broadcast team for Friday night's game with Jerry Baker, Mark Jaynes, Allison Hayes and Johnson teaming to host Saturday's three contests.

The prime time game on Friday night pits top-ranked Zionsville (30-4-1) and unranked Roncalli (22-9) with both schools looking for their first baseball crowns.

The Class A final is a matchup of Daleville (20-9) and Lanesville (15-11) – two unranked teams enjoying the spotlight of representing their schools in a state championship game for the first time in any sport.

In Class 2A, top-ranked Lafayette Central Catholic (33-1) will face off against fourth-ranked, first-time participant Providence (26-3). Lafayette Central Catholic, the lone returnee from last year, will be gunning for a record-tying eighth baseball title and first in 2A after dominating the Class A state tournament in recent years.

The weekend finale and calls for unranked Western (18-13) and first-time participant Northview (24-6) to decide the Class 3A championship. Western will be after its second title in five years while Northview hopes to do what no other team in school history has done before.



#### Crawfordsville's Mark Maxwell named this year's Outstanding Official

Mark Maxwell of Crawfordsville is the recipient of the 2016 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of Baseball. Mark will be honored in a special ceremony at this weekend's state finals.



Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.

Mark was selected for this honor by a committee representing the Indiana officials associations. He has officiated 12 sectionals, nine regionals, six semi-states, and three state finals during his 15 years as a licensed baseball official. He last officiated the baseball state finals in 2012. Trent is also licensed to

officiate Football, Basketball, and Softball, having officiated in both the 2009 Softball State Finals and 2009 and 2013 Football State Finals. Mark is a member of the Western Officials Assocation.

Taking an active role in the WIOA, Mark has served as the Association's President, Vice President, and Executive Secretary. In addition to his service with his own officials association, he has also given his time as a mentor to young officials in the Crawfordsville Youth Baseball league.

Mark is a 1969 graduate of Darlington High School, and studied History and Physical Education at Indiana State University.

The State Garage, opposite the centerfield entrance on the northeast corner of Maryland and West streets is nearby as is the underground garage northwest of the stadium for the NCAA, Indiana State Museum, Eiteljorg Museum and White River State Park.

**Services:** Starting lineups and game programs will be circulated to members of the media in the press box. Official box scores will be available following each of the four state championship games and also posted to the IHSAA website. The Indianapolis Indians provide complimentary wireless internet access within the press box. A password which is posted in the press area is needed for access.

**Photography:** Photographers may take up positions in the outfield portion of each dugout for field level shots. At no time during the game should photographers be shooting from the playing field itself.

**Post-Game Interviews:** IHSAA Champions Network personnel and photographers receive priority but interviews with coaches and players may be conducted on the field following the conclusion of the awards ceremonies. In order to allow the grounds crew to do its work, we ask your cooperation in conducting interviews outside the foul lines.
