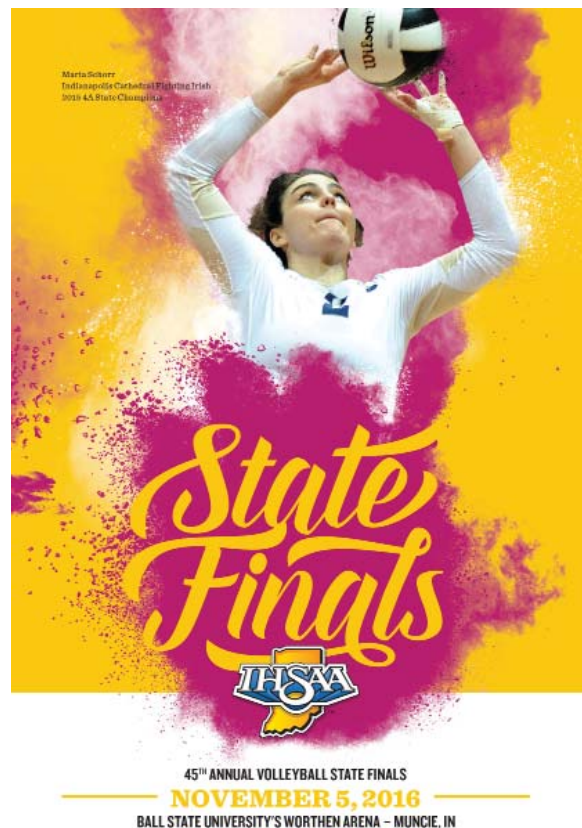

**LAPORTE'S CARY SCHNICK
TO BE HONORED WITH
OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD**

Cary Schnick of LaPorte is the recipient of the 2016 Interscholastic Athletic Officials Association Award for excellence in the sport of volleyball. Schnick will be honored in a special ceremony at today's state finals.

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation

of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.

During his career, Cary has officiated 36 sectionals, 19 regionals, three semi-states, and four state finals.

Schnick was selected for this honor by a committee representing the officials' associations. In Indiana there are 24 associations made up of men and women who assist in providing wholesome, worthwhile, and healthy activities for the student athletes in our state. State-wide, there are more than 8,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 11 sports.

A licensed referee for 40 years, Schnick is a member of the Hoosier Athletic Officials Association, for whom he has served as a clinician. Cary, also an IHSAA clinician, is a licensed referee in both baseball and softball as well.

Cary Schnick is a 1971 graduate of Elston High School in Michigan City. He has retired from his occupation as an electrician for NIPSCO, but he continues his work as a volunteer fireman for the Center Twp. Fire Department – a role he has served for the past 38 years. Cary and his wife Marilyn have been married for 41 years and have four children: Rebecca (40), Robert (38), Allan (36), and Cory (34).

- Christian Academy is the defending Class A state champion and is making its third consecutive appearance in the volleyball state finals.
- Warriors have earned their way back to the state championship match with five starters from last year's 29-8 state championship team.
- Team has won nine straight matches to this point and 12 straight in state tournament action. During this two-year run, they've won 36 of 39 sets from their opponents dropping two in last year's championship match and one last Saturday to Tindley.
- CAI swept #5 Tecumseh 3-0 - the only ranked team its faced during state tournament action - in last Saturday's Loogootee Semi-State semifinal round.
- Two of the Warriors' six regular season losses have come at the hands of other state finalist teams: lost to 3A Providence (3-0) on Sept. 26 and 2A Wapahani (2-0) on Oct. 8.
- According to MaxPreps.com statistics, senior MacKenzie Haworth ranks second in the state in the state in service aces with 145 (1.5 per set). Junior Alli Stumler is fourth in the state in hitting percentage at .492 followed by senior Sierra Rayzor at .438.
- Christian Academy of Indiana will play in the Class 2A volleyball state tournament the next two seasons due to the Tournament Success Factor.
- Formerly known as Graceland Christian, the school changed its name to Christian Academy of Indiana for 2003-04 school year.

- Blackhawk defeated a pair of top 10 teams at the Caston Semi-State last Saturday to earn their first trip to the state finals - swept #9 Daleville 3-0 and #2 Lafayette Central Catholic, last year's state runner-up, 3-2.
- Braves won sixth straight sectional crown with a 3-0 win over Bethany Christian on Oct. 22 and fourth consecutive regional title with a 3-0 sweep of Triton on Oct. 25.
- With a victory on Saturday, Blackhawk Christian would participate in the Class 2A volleyball state tournament for the 2017, 2018 seasons due to the Tournament Success Factor.

- Third team from the school to participate in a state championship contest - boys soccer team finished as 2012 Class A state runner-up and girls basketball team ended as 2016 Class 2A runner-up last winter.
- One of three schools (Crown Point, Fort Wayne Blackhawk Christian) making initial trip to the volleyball state finals on Saturday.
- Warriors returned six starters from last year's squad that finished 26-9.
- Team has won eight straight matches to this point and taken 24 of 27 sets during that span.
- One of its five regular season losses was a 3-0 decision to 4A state finalist Indianapolis Cathedral on Oct. 5.
- According to MaxPreps.com stats, junior Alison Ford rates among the state leaders with 417 kills (3.8 per set) this season. Junior Hope Notter ranks 19th in assists (1,039 (9.5 per set). Junior Liz Pelley also rates among the top 50 in service aces with 75 (0.7 per set).
- Covenant Christian's Brooke Stamper at 23 years old, is a first-year head coach. She is a 2011 graduate of the school.

- Defending state champion and top-ranked Wapahani playing for its fifth volleyball state championship and fourth in last six years. School is 4-0 in state title matches.
- Raiders return seven starters from last season's 27-11 squad that captured the state title. That team became fourth state champion with double-digit losses during the regular season.
- According to MaxPreps.com stats, junior Lexi Spence is second in the state with 1,205 assists (10.9 per set), junior Skyler Van Note ranks ninth in the state in kills with 535 (4.8 kills per set) and 20th with a .413 hitting percentage.
- Raiders have turned back top 10 foes in each of their last five state tournament matches. Swept Monroe Central and Muncie Burriss, both tied for 10th in 2A, during the sectional, defeated #6 Alexandria 3-0 in the regional, #8 Hammond Bishop Noll 3-0 and #7 Rochester for the semi-state crown.
- Faced three state finalist opponents during the regular season and went 1-2 in those matches. Lost to 3A Yorktown 3-0 on Aug. 30 and 2-0 to Providence on Oct. 8 followed that same day by a 2-0 win over 1A finalist Christian Academy of Indiana.
- Raiders finished first in the Mid-Eastern Conference this season with a 7-0 record.
- Raiders will participate in the Class 3A volleyball state tournament the next two seasons due to the Tournament Success Factor. School competed in Class 3A during the 2013, 2014 seasons before returning to 2A.

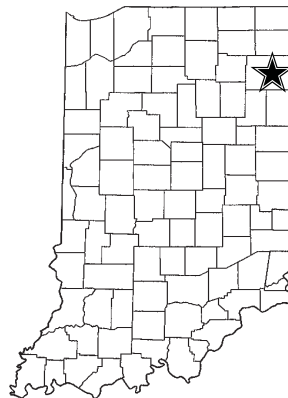
