



- One of IHSAA's earliest member schools joining the Association in 1904, one year after the organization was founded.
- School claimed the 1926 wrestling state championship, seven years before the IHSAA began sponsoring the sport. School has had two other state championship appearances finishing as the 1988 3A football runnerup and 2008 2A baseball runner-up.






