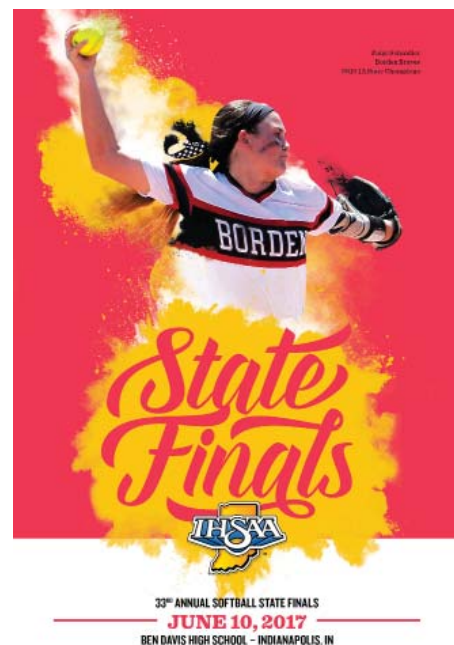

E-mail requests MUST originate from a recognized business account; e-mails from personal accounts (ie: yahoo.com, aol.com, etc.) will not be accepted. The application deadline is Thursday, June 8, at 4 pm ET / 3 pm CT. Approved requests will be available for pickup at the main gate nearest the right field corner on Saturday.

SERVICES: Starting lineups and game programs will be circulated to members of the media in attendance on Saturday. Final box scores will be available following each state championship game, posted to the IHSAA website and available via @IHSAA1 on Twitter. Complimentary wireless access also will be available in the press box for filing purposes.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Photographers may take up positions in the photography stands in the outfield side of each dugout for field level shots. At no time during the game should photographers be shooting from the playing field itself.

Tommy Thomason of Jasper is the recipient of the 2017 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of Softball. He will be honored in a special ceremony during Saturday's state finals.

The Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.



Tommy has been a licensed softball official for 21 years, during which he has officiated 19 sectionals, 13 regionals, three semi-states, and three state championships in 2006, 2010, and 2015. He is a member of the Southwestern Officials Association, and is licensed to officiate football, volleyball, and basketball in addition to softball.

Having attended high school in Terry Montana, Tommy is a retired US Navy Aircraft Maintenance Avionics Technician. While in the Navy, he umpired softball and baseball games in California, Hawaii, and Japan. He is also a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Jasper Post 673, the Disabled American Veterans Jasper Chapter, The American Legion Montana Post 32, and many others in which he has served in numerous leadership positions within those organizations.

Tommy has been married to his wife Jackie for 29 years and has four children: Trulie (41), Robin (39), Garrett (27), and Colin (24).

ICGSA Coaches Poll: #1

- Top-ranked Elwood making first state finals appearance in softball and chasing school's first IHSAA state championship.

- Panthers will take on Scecina in a rematch of their regular season meetings which saw Elwood drop both games, 7-0 and 5-0, at home on May 13.

- Team has won nine straight games and only given up two runs this tournament including a 2-1 decision over Madison-Grant in 18 innings for the sectional crown. They defeated #10 Whitko 13-0 for their first semi-state championship.

- According to MaxPreps.com stats, Elwood's MacKenzie Bryan leads the state with 275 strikeouts and ranks among the state leaders with 13 homeruns and 46 RBI this season.

- Panthers returned seven starters from last year's 18-3 team and are led by first-year coach JR Reese, a 1991 Elwood graduate.

- Champions of the Central Indiana Conference this season with a 7-0 record.

- One of IHSAA's earliest member schools joining the Association in 1904, one year after the organization was founded.

- School claimed the 1926 wrestling state championship, seven years before the IHSAA began sponsoring the sport. School has had two other state championship appearances finishing as the 1988 3A football runner-up and 2008 2A baseball runner-up.
