MEDIA CREDENTIALS: The 2017-18 IHSAA State Finals Media Credential issued previously for the girls golf and boys tennis state finals is good for admission. For those outlets without credentials and planning to cover the event, please apply by e-mailing your request (with name of individual applying) to IHSAA Sports Information Director Jason Wille at jwille@ih saa.org. E-mail requests MUST originate from a recognized business account; e-mails from personal accounts (ie: yahoo.com, gmail.com, etc.) will not be accepted.

NO CHILDREN, PLEASE: With the exception of high school students representing their school's newspaper, yearbook, radio or television station, and who have a team participating, no young people or children will be issued media credentials or be allowed in the working media area.

MEDIA WILL-CALL: Approved requests will be available for pickup at the will-call windows at Gate 4 inside Hinkle Fieldhouse beginning at 5 pm on Friday and at the northwest corner stadium entrance beginning at 9:30 am ET on Saturday.

MEDIA PARKING: While no specific media parking is available, we recommend using the Hinkle Fieldhouse parking lot on Friday and the Barnhill Parking Garage on Saturday which is just across New York Street to the north of the stadium. Each vehicle will be charged \$10 to park.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS: Except where permanent lines have been installed for those that have ordered them, an open seating policy will be used in both press boxes.

WIRELESS INTERNET: Free wireless access will be available in the press box. Please see Communications Assistant Rob Kimes who will be on site to assist you.

OFFICIAL PROGRAMS/BOX SCORES: Official programs will be available along with computer box scores following each championship match. Interviews may be conducted with players and coaches on the sidelines following the award ceremonies.

POST-GAME GUIDELINES: IHSAAtv.org personnel will have priority in conducting interviews with coaches and players on the field immediately following each match. If time permits before the awards ceremony, additional interviews may be conducted. Otherwise, all interviews will be conducted off the field following the awards ceremony and team photograph session. The post-game ceremonies order will be as follows:

FORT WAYNE CANTERBURY CAVALIERS (12-6-3)

Soccer Coaches Poll: #3

- Third-ranked Canterbury seeking record-breaking sixth state championship in boys soccer (currently tied with North Central of Indianapolis with five).
- With a victory, head coach Greg Mauch would win his record-breaking sixth state title in boys soccer (currently tied with Jerry Little of North Central of Indianapolis with five).
- School making state-leading 11th appearance in the boys soccer state finals and first since 2012 championship season.
- Cavaliers are 5-2 in state championship matches.
- Will face top-ranked Covenant Christian of Indianapolis, the school it beat 5-0 in the 2012 Class A title match.
- Junior Clayton Perry ranks among the state leaders with a 0.922 Goals Against Average with 11 allowed in 15 matches this season.
- Knocked off two ranked teams during tournament run - #2 University 1-0 for regional championship and #9 Boone Grove 3-0 for semi-state crown.
- Canterbury tied 2A state finalist Fort Wayne Concordia Lutheran 1-1 on Aug. 31.

- Top-ranked Covenant Christian returns to state championship match five years after first trip.
- Warriors will face #3 Fort Wayne Canterbury, the school they lost to 5-0 for 2012 Class A state title.
- School seeking first state championship in any sport.
- Senior Austin Wagner ranks third in the state with 24 assists according to MaxPreps.com statistics.
- Junior Jacob Susud ranks among the state leaders with a 1.29 Goals Against Average including 27 allowed in 20 matches and 105 saves.
- Team returned eight starters from last year's 11-4-3 squad that advanced to the regional round.
- Covenant defeated four consecutive ranked opponents to reach state championship match - #19 Covington 3-1 for sectional crown, #12 Greenwood Christian 3-0 and #7 Indianapolis Scecina 3-1 for regional title and #6 Providence 2-0 for the semi-state championship.
- Warriors head coach David Pfeifer is in his first season with the team after previously serving as an assistant coach at Taylor University.

WHEELER BEARCATS (21-0)

Soccer Coaches Poll: #1

- Top-ranked Wheeler advances to first soccer state championship match in school history.
- Bearcats seeking school's third state title overall.
- With a victory, Wheeler would become just the second undefeated, untied state champion joining the 2002 Carmel team which finished 25-0.
- Wheeler returned seven starters from last year's 19-2 squad.
- Team won the Greater South Shore Conference championship with a 7-0 record this season.
- Bearcats turned away three ranked opponents during its tournament journey - defeated #15 Marquette Catholic 7-1 for the sectional crown, #2 LaVille 5-0 in regional semifinals and #5 Fort Wayne Blackhawk Christian 2-0 for the semi-state championship.
- Wheeler, with 11 shutouts, has surrendered only 11 goals this season and only two during state tournament action.
- Junior Lyric Green is tied for fourth in state with 44 goals scored this year and sixth in points with 101.
- Junior Claudia Philips ranks tied for eighth in state with 20 assists.
- Head coach Bryan Murray won his 100th match while at Wheeler with last Saturday's 2-0 semi-state win.

- Defending 2A state champion Evansville Memorial boys team is making its ninth state finals appearance, second-most in state history to Fort Wayne Canterbury (11).
- Both Evansville Memorial boys and girls teams will be vying for state championships this weekend. This is the ninth time the same school has had both genders represented in the state finals and the fourth time both Tigers teams have done so (1994, 2006 and 2008). Both Memorial teams won their respective state titles in 2008, the only time that has been accomplished in tournament history.
