For those outlets without credentials and planning to cover the event, please apply by e-mailing your request (with name of individual applying) to IHSAA Sports Information Director Jason Wille at jwille@ihsaa.org. E-mail requests MUST originate from a recognized business account; e-mails from personal accounts (ie: yahoo.com, gmail. com, etc.) will not be accepted.

NO CHILDREN, **PLEASE**: With the exception of high school students representing their school's newspaper, yearbook, radio or television station, and who have a team participating, no young people or children will be issued media credentials or be allowed in the working media area.

MEDIA WILL-CALL: Approved requests will be available for pickup at the will-call windows at Gate 4 inside Hinkle Fieldhouse beginning at 5 pm on Friday and at the northwest corner stadium entrance beginning at 9:30 am ET on Saturday.

MEDIA PARKING: While no specific media parking is available, we recommend using the Hinkle Fieldhouse parking lot on Friday and the Barnhill Parking Garage on Saturday which is just across New York Street to the north of the stadium. Each vehicle will be charged \$10 to park.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS: Except where permanent lines have been installed for those that have ordered them, an open seating policy will be used in both press boxes.






