THE 82ND ANNUAL IHSAA BOYS GOLF STATE FINALS

June 12-13, 2018 Prairie View Golf Club, Carmel, Ind.


A total of 15 teams have advanced five golfers each and 25 individuals have made it here without their squads for a total of 100 participants. All teams and players will play 36 holes. Groups will be teeing off the 1^{st} and 10^{th} tees at 8 am ET / 7 am CT on Tuesday and at the same time on Wednesday.

- Top-ranked Center Grove is the defending team champion after winning its first crown a year ago. They'll attempt to become the fourth school since 2000 to repeat as team champion matching Floyd Central (2006 and 2007), Brebeuf Jesuit (2010 and 2011) and Westfield (2015 and 2016). The Trojans posted the second and third-best scores of this tournament. The Trojans carded a 288 in winning their own sectional at Hickory Stick while their 290 bested the field at Champions Pointe to win their fourth straight regional title. This will be the team's fifth consecutive appearance at state.
- Center Grove senior Noah Gillard, the Trojans' #1 player, is the defending state champion after his 72-66-138 effort here a year ago. Should he repeat as champion, he would become just the fourth player in tournament history with two titles and the first since South Bend Clay's Jeremy Wilkinson in 1994 and 1995.
- Tenth-ranked Floyd Central posted the state tournament's best score so far with a 284 in winning the Providence Sectional played at Covered Bridge Golf Club in Sellersburg. The Highlanders are back in the state finals for the 18th time after missing out the last

two seasons. They finished second to Center Grove in the regional at Champions Pointe.

- Second-ranked Carmel is making its second team appearance in four years and 32nd overall thanks to a state-best 14th regional crown Thursday at Battle Ground near Lafayette. Last year's state runners-up will attempt to land the school's sixth state championship this school having already won girls and boys tennis, boys cross country and girls and boys swimming and diving.
- This year's field of teams includes eight returning teams from last year's state finals and nine of the top 10 teams in the final regular season poll from the Indiana High School Golf Coaches Association (left).
- Third-ranked Zionsville which placed second to Carmel at the regional, will attempt to match the school's girls team which claimed its first state title last Sept. 30 on this course.
