MARENGO'S OTIS BROUGHTON TO BE HONORED WITH OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.



Otis Broughton is the recipient of the 2018-19 IHSAA Outstanding Volleyball Official Award in the state of Indiana.

A licensed volleyball official for 37 years,

Broughton is an active member of the Southwestern Indiana Officials Association.

He has assisted with the SWIOA Hospitality/Sportsmanship Golf Scramble, which awards scholarships to studentathletes who exemplify sportsmanship, for the past 14 years. Otis also started a pilot program in 1984 with former Assistant Commissioner Mildred Ball, where high school seniors would take officiating sports classes for Advance PE Credit and their IHSAA licenses. This program is still going on today at Crawford County High School. In addition to volleyball, he is also a licensed baseball, softball, basketball, and track/cross country official.

He has worked 17 sectionals, 10 regionals, four semi-states and two state finals matches during his career. He has also officiated church volleyball and basketball leagues over the years, and his favorite part of being an official is watching the benefits of high school sports extend far beyond the court or field.

Otis was selected for this honor by a committee representing the officials associations. In Indiana there are 24 associations made up of more than 6,000 men and women who assist in providing wholesome, worthwhile, and healthy activities for the studentathletes in our state. Statewide, there are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 18 sports.


