OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD**

Andy Simpson of Crown Point is the recipient of the 2019 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of Softball. He will be honored in a special ceremony during Saturday's state finals.

The Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.



Andy has been a licensed softball official for 22 years, during which he has officiated 18 sectionals, 12 regionals, six (6) semi-states, and four (4) state championships in 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016. He is a member of the Lake County Athletic Officials Association, and currently sits on the LCAOA Hall of Fame Committee and serves as an officials recruitment specialist for the association and the IHSAA. Simpson is also licensed to officiate football and basketball, and has officiated numerous state finals in those sports.

Andy is a graduate from Highland High school and is currently retired after working at Arcelor Mittal Steel USA as a Reliability Engineer for over 37 years. Andy has been married to his wife Barbara for 10 years.

E-mail requests MUST originate from a recognized business account; e-mails from personal accounts (ie: yahoo.com, aol.com, etc.) will not be accepted. The application deadline is Thursday, June 6, at 4 pm ET / 3 pm CT.

WILL-CALL: Approved requests will be available for pickup at will-call located at the tent in front of Alexander Field (adjacent baseball stadium) on Saturday.

PRESS BOX ACCESS: Credentialed news media should enter at Gate 2 and then take the elevator up to the press box. Broadcast crews will have assigned booths while an open seating policy will be used in the main press box for writers.

SERVICES: Starting lineups and game programs will be circulated in the press box. Final box scores will be distributed following each state championship game, posted to IHSAA.org and available via @IHSAA1 on Twitter. Complimentary wireless access also will be available.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Photographers may take up positions in the outfield portion of each dugout for field level shots. At no time during the game should photographers be shooting from the playing field itself.

INTERVIEWS: Interviews with coaches and players may be conducted on the field following the conclusion of the game but must not interfere with the post-game awards ceremonies. In order to allow the grounds crew to do its work, we ask your cooperation in conducting interviews outside the foul lines.
