The Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstand-



ing official in each of 11 sports during the school year.

Andy has been a licensed softball official for 22 years, during which he has officiated 18 sectionals, 12 regionals, six (6) semi-states, and four (4) state championships in 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016. He is a member of the Lake County Athletic Officials Association, and currently sits on the LCAOA Hall of Fame Committee and serves as an officials recruitment specialist for the association and the IHSAA. Simpson is also licensed to officiate football and basketball, and has officiated numerous state finals in those sports.

Andy is a graduate from Highland High school and is currently retired after working at Arcelor Mittal Steel USA as a Reliability Engineer for over 37 years. Andy has been married to his wife Barbara for 10 years.






