**GOSHEN'S ANNE GRIFFITH TO BE
HONORED WITH OFFICIALS AWARD**

Anne Griffith of Goshen is the recipient of the 2021 Interscholastic Athletic Officials Association Award for Excellence in the sport of softball. She will be honored in a special ceremony during this weekend's State Finals.

The Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.



Anne has been a licensed softball official for 29 years, during which she has officiated 14 sectionals, 12 regionals, 11 semi-states, and five state championships in 2004, 2008, 2012, 2016, and 2019. She is a member of the Saint Joe Valley, Northern Indiana, and Northeastern Indiana Officials Associations, and currently serves as an IHSAA clinician, and as a board member and secretary for the Saint Joe Valley Association. Griffith is also licensed to officiate football and unified flag football.

Griffith is a graduate from Concord High School and Indiana University. She is currently a middle school teacher and assistant athletic director for Middlebury Community Schools and resides in Goshen with her husband, Roger.

GOSHEN'S ROGER GRIFFITH TO BE HONORED WITH OFFICIALS AWARD

Roger Griffith of Goshen was the recipient of the 2020 Interscholastic Athletic Officials Association Award for Excellence in the sport of softball. Roger was to be honored at the 2020 Softball State Finals until the pandemic cancelled last season so he is being recognized at this year's event.



The Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.

Roger has been a licensed softball official for 24 years, during which he has officiated 16 sectionals, 10 regionals, seven semi-states, and three state championships in 2009, 2013 and 2017. He is a member of six different officials associations in Indiana (Calumet, Lake County, Northern Indiana, Northeastern Indiana, Saint Joe Valley, and Tri-State) and has served in numerous leadership positions in each. Roger currently serves as an IHSAA clinician, local association rules interpreter and local association clinician. Griffith is also licensed to officiate football and wrestling, and has officiated five state finals in wrestling. In addition to his involvement with high school athletics, Roger works alongside a food pantry to address food insecurity in Elkhart County and has officiated in state, regional and national tournaments for USA Softball.

Griffith is a graduate of Lincoln Community High School in Standwood, Iowa, and is currently a sales representative at Hollett Enterprise for 14 years. He currently resides in Goshen with his wife, Anne. Roger has two children, Jeremy and Rebecca.

- Unranked Northfield making school's first appearance in the softball state finals.
- Norse knocked off the top four teams in Class A during this tournament including three consecutive to win the program's first sectional championship.
- Defeated #2 North Miami (avenged regular season loss), #4 Caston and #3 West Central in their first three games of the post-season. Beat top-ranked South Central (Union Mills) in the semi-state crown.

SULLIVAN GOLDEN ARROWS (28-4)

ICGSA Coaches Poll: #10

- Sullivan playing in second-ever softball state finals and first time since 1985, the first year of the IHSAA state tournament. Arrows fell in the quarterfinal round that year when eight teams made up the state finalists during the single class era.

- Team riding a 12-game win streak and aiming to capture school's first state championship in any sport.

- Golden Arrows won first sectional in 20 years with its 7-3 victory over Linton-Stockton on May 26.

- Sullivan knocked off #3 Union County 9-8 to win its first semi-state championship last Saturday night.
- One of four first-time state finalists in this year's event (Clay City, Guerin Catholic, Northfield).
- Finished in a three-way tie for first place in the Western Indiana Conference (WIC) with a 9-1 mark.
- Eighth-year coach Lela Earley, a 1995 Sullivan graduate, previously led North Central (Farmersburg) to the 2006 Class A state finals.
- Sullivan's baseball team finished as state runner-up in 1976.
