**GARY WEIDEMAN TO BE  
HONORED WITH OFFICIALS AWARD**

Gary Weideman of Bloomington is the recipient of the 2022 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of Softball. Gary will be honored during an on-field ceremony at this weekend's IHSAA State Finals.

The Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.



Gary has been a licensed softball official for 26 years, during which he has officiated 24 sectionals, 13 regionals, five (5) semi-states, and five (5) state championships in 2005, 2010, 2014, 2017, and 2022 (Friday's 3A state championship). He is also a licensed basketball and volleyball official and has worked two Volleyball State Finals. Gary was a USA Softball official from 1992 until 2009, overseeing numerous state, regional, and national finals in slow pitch and fast pitch softball.

Gary is a member the Southwestern Indiana Officials Association and the Mid-State Officials Association and has served as an IHSAA clinician for basketball, softball, and volleyball for several years.

Gary is a 1970 graduate from Maconaquah High School and a 1986 graduate of Indiana University. He worked as a Computer Systems Analyst for the City of Bloomington for 43 years. He is currently retired and resides in Bloomington with his wife Linda.

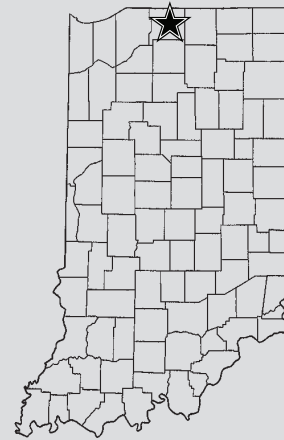
