**SCHERERVILLE'S BRANKO JASNIC
TO BE HONORED WITH
OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD**

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2022-23 IHSAA Outstanding Soccer Official in the state of Indiana is Branko Jasnic from Schererville, Indiana.

Branko was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.



Branko has been licensed in the sport of soccer for 19 years and he has been a crew member for 23 different sectionals, 14 regionals, six (6) semi-states, and has had three (3) state finals appearances!

Branko serves as a board member and Soccer Program Chair of the Lake County Officials Association. He is also an IHSAA Soccer Clinician, serving since 2014. Branko is also a licensed IHSAA softball official and served as an USSF Official from 1994-2019.

Branko consistently volunteers his time to the sport of soccer, even when he is not on the playing field. He assists other IHSAA soccer officials as a mentor, has taken time to help recruit new officials to the IHSAA and has also assisted officials and administration at the IHSAA Soccer State Finals for several years. Branko has officiated and organized numerous summer tournaments through his church and has aided the Chesterton High School and Munster High School summer scrimmages for the past few years. The officials who work these scrimmages donate their pay to different charitable organization in the community on behalf of the Lake County Officials Association.

Officiating is something that has brought joy to Branko by, not only allowing him to continue to be around the game that he loves, but giving him the opportunity to be a positive role model for his community. He's grateful for the relationships officiating has brought into his life and for being able to share his knowledge and experience with younger officials to help them grow.

Branko resides in Schererville with his wife of 26 years, Myra. Together, they have two daughters, Kristina (22), and Sofia (19).
