OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

MONTGOMERY'S NICK WININGER TO BE HONORED AT STATE FINALS

Nick Wininger of Montgomery, Indiana is the recipient of the 2024-25 IHSAA Outstanding Official Award for the sport of Girls Basketball.

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each sport. Officials selected for this distinction have gone above and beyond to serve their association, community, and the IHSAA. Each has shown exceptional qualities of leadership, dedication, and loyalty to their sport, our student-athletes, and their fellow officials.



Nick has been a licensed IHSAA basketball official for 25 years and has overseen 21 girls' sectionals, 15 regionals, 10 semi-states, and five (5) girls basketball state championship games, including today's 3A state championship. In addition, Wininger has many years of experience in the boys basketball state tournament, including three (3) boys basketball state finals (2013, 2016, and 2021). He is also licensed in the sport of baseball.

Wininger is a member of the Southwestern Officials Association and served as the basketball chair of the association from 2012-2014. He's also worked as an IHSAA clinician, in which he conducts training tutorials on officiating situations and rule changes.

Nick has been integral in the recruitment and training of officials in his community and has served as guest speaker at North Daviess High School's Officiating 101 class. He has also volunteered his time officiating and coaching in Montgomery's youth basketball and baseball leagues.

The most enjoyable part of being an official for Nick is the relationships he has built with other officials, coaches, players, and athletic directors throughout the state of Indiana over the last 25 years. He's thankful that officiating has allowed him to stay connected to the game of basketball!

Nick works as a teacher and coaches girls golf at North Daviess Community Schools. He and his wife have two children – Hadley, 11, and Holden, 6.

Nick was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials' associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 11 sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes in Indiana.
