OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

TERRE HAUTE'S STEVE MORRIS TO BE HONORED

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2024-25 IHSAA Outstanding Volleyball Official in the state of Indiana is Steve Morris from Terre Haute, Indiana. Steve was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials' associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.



Steve has been licensed in the sport of volleyball for 32 years and he has overseen 23 different sectionals, 18 different regionals, and nine (9) semi-state contests. Additionally, Steve has been a part of four state finals volleyball officiating crews (2006, 2016, 2018, 2020)! Steve is also a licensed IHSAA football, softball, and basketball official and has worked numerous state finals events in each sport.

Steve is a member of the Wabash Valley Officials Association and Western Indiana Officials Association and has served in various roles with both associations including as sports chair, board member, president, vice president, and secretary. Steve also volunteers his time as an IHSAA clinician for each sport that he is licensed, assisting with clinics and training in service to other officials in his community. In addition, he also works as a mentor to several younger officials, providing them with helpful insight from his years of experience.

Outside of the IHSAA, Steve has served as a Special Olympics Official for more than 10 years and has worked as a line judge for many NCAA Men and Women's Volleyball contests.

Steve takes pride in being a mentor and trainer, often aiding in recruitment for both new and existing officials in his community and throughout the state. Officiating has given Steve the opportunity to give back and change the lives of many student-athletes in Indiana. More than anything, he is thankful for the various relationships he's fostered as a result of officiating over the years.

Steve resides in Terre Haute with his wife and, together, they have two children. He currently works as a Training and Facilities Manager for Haute Hospitality of Terre Haute, IN.

- Top-ranked Trinity Lutheran is playing in its fourth state championship match and first in three years.
- With three previous state runner-up finishes, the Cougars are chasing that elusive first state title. A victory would represent the first state championship in school history in any sport.
- Cougars have not lost a set this tournament sweeping all six opponents.
- Eighth-ranked Faith Christian represents the first top 10 team they've faced in the state tournament.
- Senior libero Laura Roeder ranks fifth in the state with 593 digs (5.34 per set). Senior setter Addison Darlage ranks seventh in the state in assists with 1,041 (9.38 per set).
- One of two Jackson County teams participating on Saturday (Brownstown Central 2A).
- Defeated Rising Sun 3-0 on Oct. 19 to claim its 11th consecutive sectional crown.
- Team lost to 2A state finalist and county rival Brownstown Central 2-1 on Aug. 31. Also dropped a 2-1 decision to defending state champion Southwood (now playing in 2A) on Sept. 7.

- Eighth-ranked Faith Christian making its first appearance in the volleyball state finals this weekend.
- School is looking for second state championship in eight days after the girls soccer team captured the first-ever state crown in 1A last Friday night at Carroll Stadium in Indianapolis.
- School joined the IHSAA membership in 2010 and team played in its first state tournament two years later.
- Eagles will meet their fifth top 10-ranked team in seven matches this tournament when they face No. 1 Trinity.
- Faith knocked out #2 town rival Lafayette Central Catholic 3-0 in the sectional semifinals on Oct. 19 avenging a regular season loss and then swept Riverton Parke that evening to win their third straight sectional championship.
- Following the sectional title, the Eagles proceeded to sweep #6 Daleville to win its first regional title, and #5 Seton Catholic and #10 South Newton for its first semi-state.
- Finished second in the Midwest Conference with a 6-1 record this season.
- Four starters returned from last year's 30-4 sectional title team.

- Five starters return from last year's 20-9 club including senior hitter Raegan Durbin who ranks sixth in the state with 557 kills (5.9 per set). Senior setter Janie Ransom ranks fourth in the state with 1,070 assists (11.4 per set).
- Team hitting with a .315 percentage this season, the best of any of the state finalists.
- Stars have toppled three top 10 teams this tournament including #2 Benton Central in the sectional championship, #8 defending state champion Muncie Burriss for the regional crown, and #3 Southwood (last year's 1A champ) in five sets during the semi-state.
- Finished third in this year's Sagamore Conference race with a 5-2 mark.

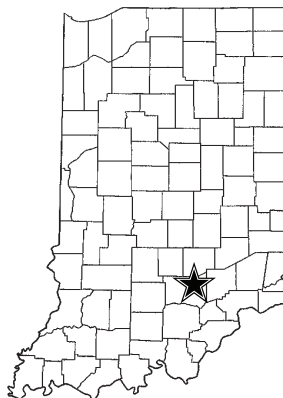

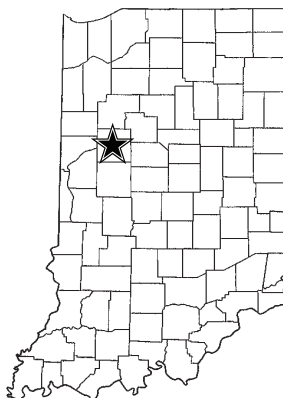
