OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

EVANSVILLE'S GREG GOTT TO BE HONORED WITH GIRLS AWARD

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2024-25 IHSAA Outstanding Girls Soccer Official is Greg Gott from Evansville, Indiana. Greg was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials' associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.



Greg has been licensed in the sport of soccer for 23 years and he has overseen 12 girls' soccer sectionals, 11 regionals, three semi-states, and one state championship contest in 2019. Additionally, Greg has officiated 15 boys' soccer sectionals, 10 regionals, three semi-states, and one state championship contest in 2022.

Greg is a member of the Southern Indiana Association and volunteers his time as an IHSAA Officials Mentor, providing numerous younger officials with helpful insight from his years of experience. Greg has served as the Soccer Chair for the Southern Indiana Association since 2012, playing an integral role in the support of soccer officials in Southern Indiana. He also volunteers his time assisting with IHSAA Soccer Certification Clinics annually.

Outside of his work with the IHSAA, Greg has been licensed with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF) for 25 years and 15 years as a National Intercollegiate Soccer Official Association (NISOA) official.

Greg takes great pride in helping prepare student-athletes for their futures after high school sports in Indiana by providing a safe and fun environment for all to participate.

Greg resides in Evansville with his wife, Beth, and together they have three children. He works as an Engineering Designer for an electronics company in Chandler, Indiana.

Greg is a member of the Fall Creek Association and volunteers his time as an IHSAA clinician, assisting with clinics and trainings in service to other officials in his community. - Cougars topped a pair of other ranked teams this tournament - #15 Indianapolis Lutheran in the sectional and #12 Oldenburg in the regional.
- After a scoreless tie against Indianapolis Lutheran during the regular season, Greenwood Christian scored a 1-0 victory in a rematch two weeks later to win its third straight sectional crown.
- Team is led by first year coach Kefil Tonouewa, who was an assistant coach with the 2022 runner-up team.

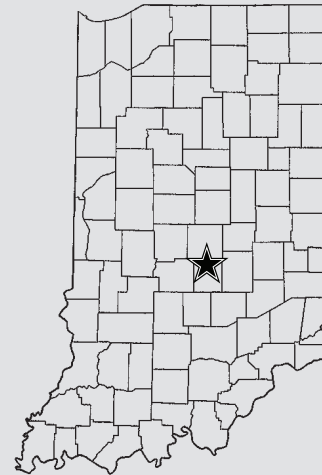
