EIGHT TEAMS AIM FOR BOYS BASKETBALL TITLES

A defending state champion, a six-time state finalist and six schools that have never traveled this far before comprise the field for the 89th Indiana High School Athletic Association Boys Basketball State Finals. The second multiple-class state tournament will culminate Saturday (March 27) at the RCA Dome in Indianapolis when four champions are crowned.

The field includes Lafayette Central Catholic, the inaugural Class A state champion and the only state finalist to return from the 1998 finals. Elkhart Central has reached the finals for the sixth time, while Tecumseh, Paoli, Westview, Muncie Southside, Plainfield and North Central of Indianapolis are here for the first time each.

Plainfield comes in with the field's best record at 25-1 and is the only top-ranked team to survive the first three weeks of tournament play. The Quakers, who are the first team in Hendricks County history to play in the boys basketball state finals, have won 10 straight since suffering their only loss of the season Feb. 6 at Lebanon. Paoli, riding a 12-game run, owns the field's longest winning streak.

Paoli, Muncie Southside and Elkhart Central weren't ranked in the season's final Associated Press media poll that is divided by classes. In the unified Indiana Basketball Coaches Association poll, Plainfield is the highest surviving team. The Quakers were No. 3 and North Central was No. 11. None of the other six state finalist teams were rated in the IBCA top 20.

STATE FINALS NOTES

CLASS A

TECUMSEH

Ranked No. 7 in final Associated Press Class A poll . . . The 34-year-old consolidation of Lynnville and Elberfeld is located near Lynnville in northern Warrick County about 25 miles northeast of Evansville . . . Braves won school's first boys basketball sectional, regional and semi-state titles on their march to the dome . . . First state finals appearance in any IHSAA team sport for Tecumseh . . . Coach Kevin Oxley, 37, graduated from Tecumseh and is in his 15th year on the coaching staff, the last seven as head coach with a record of 70-82 . . . Four players score in double figures, led by junior guard Jeremy Broshears at 15.3.

LAFAYETTE CENTRAL CATHOLIC

Ranked eighth in final Associated Press Class A poll . . . Only returning finalist from 1998 despite losing five players from that team . . . Was first Catholic school to play in an IHSAA boys basketball state championship game and one of two (Indianapolis Cathedral, Class 3A, 1998) to win a state title . . . Parochial and private schools were first admitted to the IHSAA in 1942-43; Lafayette Central Catholic joined in its first year of existence, 1957-58 . . . Trying to become the 14th team to win consecutive boys basketball state titles, the first since Ben Davis in 1996 and the first in the multiple-class format . . . This year's sectional title at Sheridan was the fourth in school history . . . Senior center Eric Washington leads the Knights in points (13.1), rebounds (8.8), blocked shots (53) and steals (38) . . . Coach Chad Dunwoody, 27, is the nephew of Martinsville girls basketball coach Jan Conner, who guided the Artesians to state titles in 1997 and 1998 (Class 4A) . . . Dunwoody's brother, Todd, is an outfielder for the Florida Marlins.

CLASS 2A

PAOLI

Unranked in final Associated Press Class 2A poll, but eliminated three ranked opponents -- No. 9 Eastern (Bloomfield) in regional, No. 2 Winchester and No. 1 Monrovia in the semi-state -- to earn its first state finals trip ... Rams had never won a regional title prior to 1989; they've won six in the last 11 seasons, all under coach Mike Brown, 42 ... Paoli has won seven of its 21 sectional titles during Brown's 11 seasons (239-110) on the bench ... One of the oldest schools among the 386 IHSAA member schools, joining the IHSAA in 1905-06 ... This is school's first appearance in a IHSAA state finals in a team sport ... Third Orange County team to reach the boys basketball state finals, joining Springs Valley (1958) in its first year of existence and Orleans (1913) when 16 teams advanced to a single site. Springs Valley fell in the semifinals and Orleans in the quarterfinals ... Senior center Tristan Vance leads Rams in scoring (12.9) and rebounding (6.4) ... Senior guard Dusty Cole is the only other double-digit scorer at 12.7 ... Cole is one of several football players on the Ram roster and ranked eight in state receiving yardage per game for the 1998 season with 84.6 yards. He caught 50 passes in 11 games for 931 yards and 13 touchdowns ... Starting junior forward Derek VanEmon ranked 26th in state passing yardage for 1998, averaging 144.4 yards per game ... Brown goes to the bench early, usually employing nine players in the first quarter.

WESTVIEW

Ranked No. 5 in final Associated Press Class 2A poll . . . The 33-year-old consolidation of Shipshewana-Scott and Topeka is in southwestern LaGrange County, about 20 miles southeast of Elkhart . . . First appearance in an IHSAA team sport state finals by any LaGrange County school . . . Coach Troy Neely, 37, is in the third season of his second stint (67-33) on the Westview bench. He also coached the Warriors for two seasons in the late 1980s . . . As a player, Neely led the state in scoring as a senior in 1979-80 at Jimtown with a 28.1 average . . . Warriors are balanced offensively with three players averaging 11 points a game, topped by junior forward Scott Hostetler at 11.8 . . . Junior forward Derek Yoder (11.7) and junior center Jeff Nelson (11.2) are right behind on a balanced team that sees 10 players in the typical rotation . . . The three Yoders on the roster -- juniors Derek, Eric and Jason -- are not related.

CLASS 3A

Ranked No. 1 in final Associated Press Class 3A poll and No. 3 in final Indiana Basketball Coaches Association (unified) poll \dots Beat three top 10 (AP) teams -- No. 10 Indianapolis Cathedral in the sectional, No. 6 Madison and No. 2 Gibson Southern in the semi-state -- on its journey to the dome \dots First Hendricks County school to capture a boys basketball semi-state title \dots Also the first Plainfield team in any team sport to reach the state finals \dots Coach Dana Greene, 48, is in his 11th season (145-100) with the Quakers after serving as an assistant to former coach Larry Bullington \dots Quakers are led by 6-5 senior Gavin Groninger, who has signed a basketball letter of intent with Michigan \dots Groninger ranks 39th in state scoring this season with a 20.8 average \dots As a junior, he finished 10th on the state scoring list with a 24.8 average \dots While relinquishing part of the scoring brunt this season, he still ranks as a deep threat with a team-high 79 three-pointers.

MUNCIE SOUTHSIDE

Unranked in final Associated Press Class 3A poll . . . First boys basketball state finals appearance for the 37-year-old school . . . Stood 11-10 at conclusion of regular-season play . . . Seeking to become the first state champion with 10 regular-season losses. Anderson (1935, 22-9) and Jasper (1949, 21-9) have the most losses of any state champion . . . Third Delaware County school to reach the state finals in three years, joining 1997 runner-up Delta and 1998 Class 3A runner-up Yorktown . . . Coach Rick Baumgartner, 44, is back on the Rebel bench after spending three seasons at Richmond, his alma mater . . . He also guided the Rebels for three seasons from 1994 to 1996 . . . He has compiled a 241-181 record overall in 19 varsity seasons at South Bend St. Joseph's, Delta, Mooresville, Pendleton Heights, Richmond and Muncie Southside . . . The last first-year coach to win a state boys basketball title was Bill Green at Indianapolis Washington in 1969 . . . Rick Baumgartner's father, Dick Baumgartner, was the coach of Crawfordsville's state runner-up team in 1958 and later enjoyed a long tenure at Richmond where he coached his son . . . Freshman Ryan Baumgartner, the starting point guard for the Rebels, is the son of Rick Baumgartner . . . Junior center Gerry Hall leads the Rebels in scoring (14.8) and rebounding (11.2).

CLASS 4A

NORTH CENTRAL

Ranked No. 9 in the final Associated Press Class 4A poll and No. 11 in the Indiana Basketball Coaches Association unified poll . . . First state finals appearance in boys basketball for the 43-year-old school . . . With 3,228 students in four grades, North Central has the state's largest enrollment in one building. Ben Davis (2,589 in three grades) has more overall students if its ninth-grade students (882 in three junior highs) are counted toward the total . . . North Central ranks second in overall IHSAA titles with 43. Only Carmel (62) has won more . . . Beginning in 1989 when Lawrence North became the first Marion County township school to win an IHSAA boys basketball title, an Indianapolis suburban school has been in the state finals nine of the last 11 seasons . . . Panthers are led by 5-11 senior guard Jason Gardner, who has signed a basketball letter of intent with the University of Arizona Gardner ranks 22nd in state scoring this season with a 22.4 average Gardner was the only Indiana player selected to play in the 22nd annual McDonald's All-American Game Wednesday at Iowa State University in Ames, Iowa Gardner is scheduled to leave Indianapolis on Tuesday and return Thursday Gardner is one of nine seniors on the North Central roster . . . Coach Doug Mitchell, 42, is 91-52 in six seasons at North Central after serving as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Butler University.

ELKHART CENTRAL

Unranked in the final Associated Press Class 4A and Indiana Basketball Coaches Association polls . . . Bidding for first IHSAA boys basketball state championship in sixth appearance (three as Elkhart Central, three as Elkhart) . . . Blazers last reached the state finals in 1995, falling to eventual state runner-up Merrillville 62-49 in the semifinals . . . Coach Mike Drews, 39, is in his first season at Elkhart Central after a three-year hiatus from coaching following four seasons (59-35) as head coach at Muncie Central and 11 seasons as a Bearcat assistant under Bill Harrell which included the 1988 state championship season . . . The last first-year coach to win a state boys basketball title was Bill Green at Indianapolis Washington in 1969 . . . Blazers recovered from mid-season crisis when four inside players were lost to the team within a three-day period. Only one was able to return . . . Senior guards James Scott (18.6) and Anthony Kyle (18.3) pace the Blazers in scoring
