JAMES CRAIG TO BE HONORED WITH OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

James Craig is the recipient of the 2022 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of Baseball. James is to be honored in a special ceremony during Saturday's Baseball State Finals.

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials



Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.

James was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials associations in Indiana.

James has been a licensed baseball official for 36 years and has overseen 26 sectionals, 18 regionals, 11 semi-state contests, and eight State Finals! He is a member of the Northeastern Officials Association and previously served as an IHSAA Certification Clinician from 1999-2019. James has received the Indiana High School Baseball Coaches Association's District Empire of the Year Award over 10 times and has officiated their North-South All-Star Series three times. James is also a licensed IHSAA football official and has officiated three State Finals in the sport.

James is a mentor to several officials in his area and also volunteers his time hosting youth baseball clinics that help players understand the relationship between themselves and umpires and the benefits of the game.

James is a graduate of Indiana University-Purdue University-Fort Wayne and currently works as a Supervisor at WaterFurnace International of Fort Wayne. James resides in Fort Wayne and has one daughter, Jocelyn.
